| 4. | Psalms 42 | "My soul is downcast, therefore I will remember you." |
| 5. | Psalms 51 | "Cleanse me from my sin." |
| 6. | 2 Chronicles 20:1-22 | "We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you." |
| 7. | Matthew 6:5-15 | "Your kingdom come, your will be done." |
| 8. | Luke 18:35-43 | "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me." |
| 9. | Luke 22:40-46 | "Not my will, but yours be done." |
| 10. | John 17 | "May we be brought to complete unity." |
| 11. | Acts 4:1-31 | "Enable us to speak your word with great boldness." |
| 12. | Ephesians 3:14-21 | "May I grasp how wide and long and deep your love is." |
| 13. | Colossians 1:1-14 | "Fill me with the knowledge of your will, through all the wisdom and understanding the Spirit gives." |
